This month, we're focusing our charitable efforts on an entrepreneur affected by COVID-19.

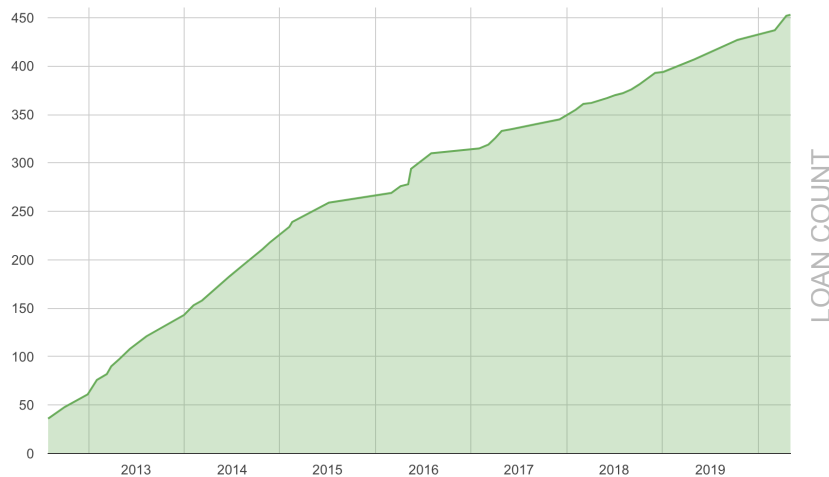


## TENISHA'S STORY
